Though victory eluded the Bobcat 11 at the Section IV Class "D" Bowl game against Deposit last Saturday morning at Cornell, our young men played to the final seconds with tenacity and determination that brought honor to themselves, their school and their community.

From the beginning of the game, the soaked artificial turf and a smothering Deposit defense conspired to slow the Bobcat offensive line. But even as the clock wound down to the final whistle with Deposit leading 21-0, the Bobcats never gave up.

With 37 seconds remaining, senior Kyle Putnam caught Adam Garrett's pass; danced around the Lumberjack defenders and blazed to the two yard line with 12 seconds left on the clock. An offside call against Deposit brought the pigskin to the 1-yard line and Garrett plunged across for the score. Garrett then tossed a bull's eye to Eric Tee for the two-point conversion.

Though the 21-8 loss to Deposit brought an otherwise undefeated season to a close, the coaches' primary job of forging individual responsibility, team-

work and character was a complete success.

"At the beginning of the season there was a general feeling that we were the 'scraps' now that (last year's graduating tailback Kevin) Kessler was gone," said Co-captain Steve Cowles. "Kessler was a great, fast 'back," agreed Adam Paddock, "but we wanted to prove we could win as a team."

"The coaches kept us working on the coldest days and built our confidence," said Paddock. "Everyone took responsibility and learned to trust (one another)," added Cowles.

"We learned (in the Trumansburg game) that we could come back by sticking together," emphasized senior Mike Norman. "Coach Redmond never yelled at us; he always helped."

Adam Paddock summed it up best. "The difference between a good team and a great team is that even if you lose a ball or a down, you still work together."

It would have been thrilling to win the Deposit game, that's for sure. But our Blue and Gold players, the Pep Band and Cheerleaders all grew in stature and self-respect. Thanks, coaches.
