Wilson Memorial Tournament.

"It was a good basketball game between two pretty good teams that could have gone either way," said Lansing coach Stuart Dean. In the end, we held them scoreless and that was the difference.

Devon Lucas and Carolyn Childers combined to sink 25 points to lead the Lady

Bobcat offensive effort.

"That Craver girl is tough," said coach Dean, "but Rachel Jackson and Carolyn Childers did a good job of keeping the ball away from her." Katie Crandall's defensive rebounding in the last minutes was decisive in keeping Watkins from coming back in the last moments, Dean added.

The tournament action brings Lansing to a 9-0 overall record (5-0 in IAC competition). "Marathon's won the IAC division championships for the past three years, so we're glad to be back in the action," said Dean. Lansing plays Marathon this Friday at 6:00 pm. Be there!
