## Trustees To Control Stockpiled Salt Runoff

structure within 10 days of the law's passage.

Tull told the Board that he has been working with Zoning and Code Enforcement Officer Ben Curtis about the village's concerns about run-off. "We have no problem with the concept of (building an) enclosure," said Tull.

However, Tull and Pyramid Operations Manager Bob Perry asked the Board to reconsider the desirability of having large salt containment domes at Pyramid and wherever else in the village salt is stored outside. They suggested that a covered, 3-sided bunker could accomplish the same goals.

Village attorney Randy Marcus explained that the ordinance had been drawn from NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) model regulations.

Mayor Hartill appeared satisfied with Pyramid's response. He said that while DEC regulations will resolve the problem, they may be at a scale more than the village needs.

"This proposed ordinance is a first cut," said Mayor Donald Hartill at the outset of the public discussion. "We want to keep the salt from being rained on continuously by getting away from open piles with a tarp on top."

In other business, the Village Trustees granted Ithaca Peripherals' request for a temporary Certificate of Occupancy for their new 26,000 square foot addition off Bomax Drive. If all goes as planned, the new facility will be occupied by March 7.
