## "Model 37" NASCAR To Carry Ithaca Gun To the Checkered Flag

With the Ithaca Gun Model 37 shotgun one of the nation's most respected sporting arms, it's no wonder that the newest NASCAR Modified Division race car Model 37 is sporting the name and colors of its famed predecessor.

The sleek yellow and red Model 37 was due to have been in its maiden race March 8 at the Tioga Speedway for the Icebreaker 40 for NASCAR Modified, but with the Southern Tier's predictably unpredictable weather the race was postponed.

With 26 year old 1996 Rookie-of-the-Year T.J. Potrzebowski at the wheel, Model 37 will cruise the Tioga Speedway circuit and compete in the popular NYS Modified Championship Series and Heatherlite Modified Tour events.

Potrzebowski and co-owner Ray Marshall have high hopes that Model 37 will

also carry them towards the 1997 Winston Racing Series Regional Championship.

Though the Southern Cayuga County NASCAR "roll out" is now history, visitors to the Ithaca Gun facility at 891 Route 34-B in King Ferry can still visit the newly opened Ithaca Gun Museum to view photos, arms and sporting memorabilia that reflect Ithaca Gun's storied history.

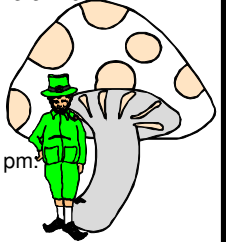
