Lansing Jogger Remains In Critical Condition

Last Wednesday evening, a little before 5:00 p.m., Warren Road resident Christopher W. Kirvin was struck by a car on Asbury Road while jogging.

Kirvin was treated at the scene for head injuries by Lansing Fire Department Advanced Emergency Medical Technician Phil Miller and Bang's Ambulance and was subsequently airlifted to Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, Pennsylvania.

At the time of the accident, Kirvin carried no identification with him. He was identified Thursday with the help of friends, co-workers, and the Tompkins County Sheriff's Department.

A May, 1996 graduate of Hobart College in Geneva, NY, Kirvin is employed by Stewart Howe Alumni Service in Ithaca. Co-workers describe him as warm-hearted and good-spirited.
