Mar. 26 Sewer Committee Mtg Update

Town engineer David Herrick presented preliminary cost estimates for expanding the proposed South Lansing Sewer District to include the Buck Road, Sharon Drive, Franklyn Drive and Maple Drive neighborhoods in the initial service area.

Earlier this month, the Lansing Town Board had asked Herrick to prepare these cost estimates in response to requests from individuals in these neighborhoods to be added to the initial service area.

The cost of extending service to the 105 additional dwelling units in these neighborhoods is estimated at \$144,100. With these units added to the 695 units in the previ-

ously-designated initial service area, the annual capital recovery cost per unit would increase 3 percent from \$318.00 to \$327.50.

The committee will mail copies of the cost estimates to residents in the proposed extension areas to seek consensus on a neighborhood by neighborhood basis.

According to Sewer Committee co-chairs Jeff Clark and Larry Sharpsteen, these estimated costs could be further reduced if any of the state or federal grant programs for which the Town of Lansing has applied materialize. In no event would someone outside the service area be assessed any fee, said Sharpsteen.

Ed. Commissioner Mills On WSKG Call-In Mon.

Many people know that the NYS Education department has voted to eliminate minimum competency tests. Others do not realize that all students will soon be required to pass five Regents exams (English, math, science and two in social studies) in order to earn a high school diploma.

On Monday, March 31 from 8-9:00pm, NYS Education Commissioner Richard P. Mills will host a call-in program, broadcast locally on WSKG television, where parents can call in their questions about local diplomas, special education, access to vocational education and other issues that may be affected by a shift to Regents exams for all.

Phone lines will be manned by more than 20 Education Department staffers who promise that even if your question is not answered by Commissioner Mills, you will receive an individual answer. To be sure that everyone gets a chance to get through, phone lines will be open an hour before the show begins and remain open an hour after the program ends.
