12 Lansing Students Win T-S-T BOCES Creative Writing Contest

Budding Lansing poets and writers took more than 40 percent of the honors awarded to 7-10 graders in the Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga BOCES 1997 Creative Writing Contest.

"We're pleased with the quality of our students' work," said 9th grade English teacher June Martin. She and colleague Wendy Cleveland were instrumental in encouraging our students' participation.

Michael Ducharme took first place in the 7-8 poetry section with "Rocks in my socks." Tony LaBar's "Joe Brown" won second place honors in the 9-10 grade essay contest, followed by an anonymous third place Lansing submission "Winners Never Quit." Jessica Kirk and Jonasz Ely-Ribik garnered Honorable Mentions in the 9-10 essay category.

First and second place in the 9-10 poetry category were won by Jaret Herter for "Fantasy vs. Reality" and by Emily Tucker for "Fancy" while Jennifer Farmer and Kim Schuttenberg received Honorable Mentions.

All three awards in the 9-10 short story category came to Lansing. Meghan Dean wrote "Crispin Avenue;" Ben Hardie penned "Two Bit;" and Charlie Zabriskie authored "Regents Park."

Village of Lansing — April 28 to May 1, 1997

To assist work crews and ensure that material is picked up, please:

- Place brush & limbs at the roadside before 6:00am the first day (Monday).
- Pile brush & limbs loosely with the cut ends towards the road.
- To be picked up, limb diameter must be 8 inches or less
- Do NOT tie material together. • Do NOT place in bags.
- No leaves, please

PLEASE, no more than one pick-up load per household.
