LANSING RECREATION DEPARTMENT SUMMER PROGRAM OFFERINGS

To assist you with planning your summer, we are providing a listing of programs we will be offering this summer with dates and times. This is for your information only. Registration information will be available in the schools and at the Recreation Department Office in the Town Hall approximately May 12. We have indicated the fees for each of the programs. Scholarships are available for most programs. Call the Recreation Office at 533-7388 for information. Programs to be offered this summer by the Lansing Recreation Department are:

- Summer Day Camp** - Session 1: July 7 - 18; Session 2: July 21 - August 1; Session 3: August 4 - 15 [All sessions are 10:00 am - 3:00 pm] Fee: \$30 per child per session
Before and After Camp Care is also offered from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm for a fee of \$40 per week.
- Instructional Swimming:** Session 1 - June 30 - July 18 (no class on July 4); Session 2 July 21-August 8. Times vary according to class level. All lessons are conducted between 8:00 am and 12 Noon and range from 30 minutes to 45 minutes in length. Fee: \$18 per person per session.
- Open Swimming:** Open swimming will be offered Monday-Friday 12:10-1:30 pm on the same dates as instructional swimming. Adults - \$1.00; Students - \$.50
- Instructional Gymnastics:** Session 1: July 7 - 18; Session 2: July 21 - August 1. Times vary according to class level; all lessons are conducted between 8:45 am and 12 Noon and are approximately 30 minutes in length. Fee: \$15 per person per session.
- Tennis Camp** - Session 1: June 30 - July 11; Session 2 - July 14 - 25 [Beginner 1 (minimum of 8 years of age) -- 8-9 am]; [Beginner 2 -- 9-10 am]; [Intermediate -- 10-11 am] Fee: \$15 per person per session.
- Tennis Tournament:** July 25-26. Free to those who register for Tennis Camp. Others will be charged \$5.
- Summer Softball:** Late June-Late July (For girls 13 years old by June 30 and no older than 17 by September 1) Fee: \$15 per person.
- Theater: Behind the Scene:** July 14-August 1 [10:00 am - 12:00 noon] For students entering grades 5-7 in the fall. Fee: \$25 per person.
- High School Summer Drama and Musical Program:** July 29 - August 16 [6:30-8:30 pm] For students entering grades 8-12 in the fall. Fee: \$15 per person.
- Boys' Basketball Clinic:** July 7 - 11 [3:00-6:00 pm] For boys entering grades 6, 7 or 8. Fee: \$15 per person.
- Girls' Basketball Clinic:** July 7 - 11 [5:00-7:00 pm] For girls entering grades 6 through 12. Fee: \$15 per person.
- Junior Instructional Wrestling:** July 7 - 25 [4-7 years old - 12:30-1:30 pm] [8-11 years old - 1:30-2:30 pm]. Fee: \$15 per person.
- Advanced Instructional Wrestling:** July 8, 10, 15, 17, 22, 24, 29, 31, August 5 & 7. Fee: \$10 per person.
- Junior Golf School:** Session 1: July 7 - 10; Session 2: July 14-17 [Class 1: 12:00-1:00 pm] [Class 2: 1:30-2:30 pm] Fee: \$30 per person.
- Instructional Ice Skating School:** Session 1: July 28-August 1; Session 2: August 4 - 8 [Morning session: 10:00-11:00 am] [Afternoon Session: 1:00-2:00 pm] Fee: \$30 per person per session (includes free skate rental).
- Youth Track Clinic:** July 14-26 [Mon-Fri: 6:30-8:30 am - Sat: 9:00-11:00 am] For students entering grades 3-6. Fee: \$20 per person.
- Horse Care & Riding:** Session 1: July 7-11; Session 2: July 21-25 (8 years of age and older). Fee: \$60 per person per session.
- Instructional Bowling:** August 25-29 [10:00 am - 12 noon] (5-15 years of age) Fee: \$30 per person.
