## Go-Karts Generate Sparks at Town Board Meeting; Water Surcharge Discussed

doesn't feel it will harm his neighbors. "Once they learn the specifics they'll calm down," he said hopefully. "I just want to go by the rules."

### Other Business

In other business, County Public Works Commissioner updated the Council on design modifications for the Myers Road replacement bridge. A Nov. 1 completion date is still expected.

Town Engineer David Herrick reported that the So. Lansing Sewer Advisory Committee expects to forward its completed draft report to the Town Board by mid-July.

The Town Board also deliberated about a proposal to convert the Town's water surcharge from a graduated to a flat rate. Councilman Larry Tvarhoa asked Herrick to look at current rather than historical water use to see if the projected increased water consumption generated by new hookups in re-

cent water district extensions could realistically generate the \$114,000 needed to recover town system capital, operations and maintenance costs. If this can be accomplished, it may be possible to go to a flat rate. This would help NYSEG and other industrial users without having to increase residential users' cost. The requested data is expected to be available by next week.

At the end of the meeting, Supervisor Kirby said that the Board will begin reviewing the proposed zoning ordinance, "as soon as a joint meeting with the Planning Board can be arranged." According to Planning Board Chair Larry Sharpsteen, such a meeting is "imminent."

The next meeting of the Town Board is scheduled tonight (Wednesday, Apr. 23) at 7:00 pm in the Town Hall. In addition to other regular business, the town will get an update on the Right to Farm Law.
