

Garden Painting Classes Begin May 24

Three private Lansing residential gardens and the Cornell wildflower garden will be the sites of a series of 2-session flower and garden landscape painting classes that will be taught by landscape artist William Deets and Lansing horticulturist Katrina Greenly beginning later this month.

All skill levels and media (water, acrylic and oil) are welcome. Deets will guide the small classes in composition and technique. Deets lives in Trumansburg, teaches adult evening art courses at BOCES and has exhibited his work throughout the Northeast. Ludlowville's Greenly will add a horticultural perspective to the art instruction.

Each session is \$50 for two consecutive 3-hour morning classes. Session I will be on May 24 and 31; session II will be on June 7 and 14; and session III will be June 21 and 28. session III will feature a shrub rose garden.
